

## Leafield Church Work Day – Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup>. May 2010

**10.00am to 4.00pm or sooner if the job is done**

**Don't forget to bring a picnic lunch and strong working gloves**

**The purpose of this work day is to continue clearing the ground surrounding the Church on the North side, back to the line of the boundary stones.**

**Clear such gutters at the lower levels that are accessible by ladders from the ground.**

**In the copse at the South East side of the Church, start to clear the land drain culvert along the marked line. This job will require spades.**

**The culvert appears to contain about a hundred years of leaf mould compost and very likely roots from the surrounding trees. For those of you in need of good compost please bring plastic bags.**

**Caution: The cover by the gate over the drainage sump must not be lifted.**

**Remove such Ivy and Moss from the lower walls and window ledges left over from last Work Day. – A good hoe will help.**

**Apart from spades, ladders and some bow saws will be useful.**

### Some safety Precautions

- 1 For ladder work an adult must be stationed at the foot of the ladder all the time there is a person on the ladder.**
- 2 Any Chain Saw user(s) must be wearing appropriate Safety Clothing and be familiar with the equipment.**
- 3 Children accompanying adults must be supervised.**

**Offerings to the Rain God for a dry day would be appreciated.**
